Arizona Health Sciences Library at the Phoenix Biomedical Campus Community Visitor Policy

The Arizona Health Sciences Library at the Phoenix Biomedical Campus exists primarily to serve students, staff, and faculty of University of Arizona and Northern Arizona University degree programs offered at the Phoenix Biomedical Campus (PBC). Limited community access may be available for visitors with needs not addressed at other local libraries.

All visitors without PBC access badges, regardless of institutional affiliation, must contact the library director via email (<u>dbickford@email.arizona.edu</u>) in advance in order to verify the appropriateness of library resources for their needs.

Approved visitors should check in at the security desk in the Health Sciences Education Building (HSEB) upon arrival. The security officer on duty will call the library service desk. If library staff confirm that the visit is approved, the security officer will issue a guest badge. The community visitor may then proceed to the library and sign the guest roster at the service desk.

All community visitors should be at least 18 years old. For all community visitors, access is possible only during the hours of 8 AM to 5 PM, Monday through Friday. Community visitors must abide by all library policies.

There is no free parking available at the Phoenix Biomedical Campus, and the library does not validate tickets issued by parking garages. Visitors who arrive by car may pay to park at nearby garages or on adjacent city streets. Printing requires the use of a credit or debit card to establish an account with a minimum value of \$2.
