

The Healthcare Team

Description

Summer Scrubs is a health career exploration program that helps young people prepare for their future in the health professions by providing the opportunity to participate in professional lectures and hands-on lab experiences. The Healthcare Team session is for current 9th and 10th grade students (rising sophomores & juniors) who are interested in a healthcare career, but who are unsure as to which path to take. Participants will explore several healthcare occupations by learning from medical doctors, physician assistants, nurses, pharmacists, and others who make-up the healthcare team.

Session Dates: June 17- June 21 (no camp on June 19 in observation of Juneteenth) All participants are required to attend all days of the session.

Grades: Current 9th and 10th grade students (rising sophomores & juniors)

 Location: Phoenix Biomedical Campus, Downtown Phoenix (435 N. 5th St. Phoenix, AZ 85004)
 Cost: \$250 *Need-based scholarships are available*
