

## **UA COM-P Chemical Waste Disposal**

Chemical waste is picked-up from research laboratories located at ABC-1, the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of TGen, and Chandler Innovations on a quarterly basis, or as needed. Researchers will receive an email notification from the Laboratory Coordinator to provide an inventory of chemical waste to be picked-up. All chemical waste containers should be tagged listing the name of the chemical, the approximate volume, and concentration. Information listed on the waste container tags should correspond with the chemical waste inventories. Chemical tags are available from the Laboratory Operations Management Office.

ABC-1 Laboratories: On the day prior to chemical waste pick-up, the Laboratory Coordinator will make arrangements to collect tagged waste containers from designated chemical fume hoods in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floor laboratories.

3<sup>rd</sup> FI TGen Laboratories: Tagged waste containers should be stored in the chemical fume hood between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> laboratory bays. There is a sign indicating that this fume hood can be used for temporary storage of chemical waste.

Following the removal of chemical waste by UA Risk Management Services, researchers will receive a notice to pick-up empty waste containers within 24 hours. Any containers not collected by researchers may be discarded.
