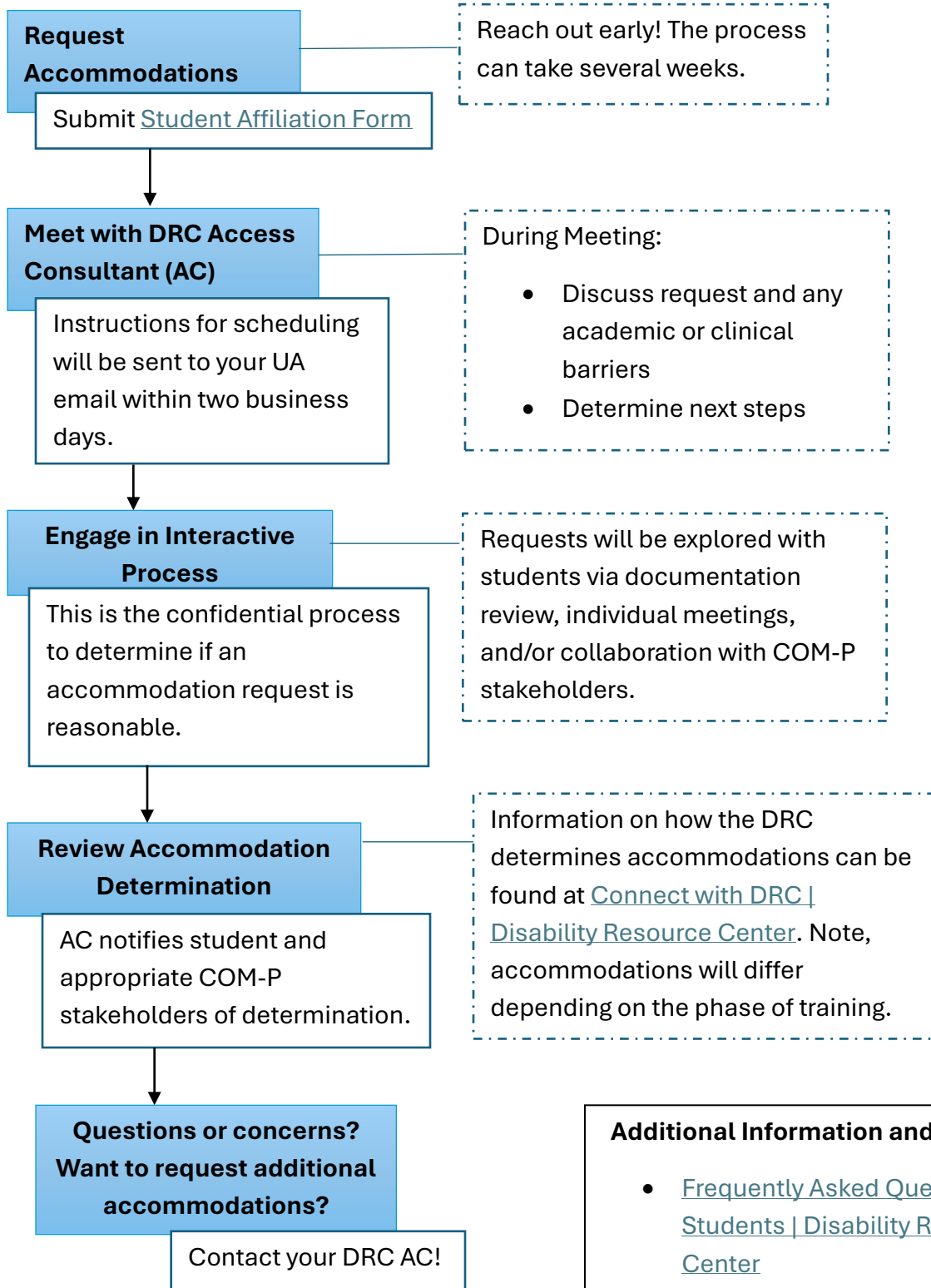

# Support for COM-P Students with Disabilities

## 1. Request Accommodations

- Submit [Student Affiliation Form](#)
- Reach out early! The process can take several weeks.

## 2. Meet with DRC Access Consultant (AC)

- Instructions for scheduling will be sent to your UA email within two business days.
- During Meeting:
  - Discuss request and any academic or clinical barriers
  - Determine next steps

## 3. Engage in Interactive Process

- This is the confidential process to determine if an accommodation request is reasonable.
- Requests will be explored with students via documentation review, individual meetings, and/or collaboration with COM-P stakeholders.

## 4. Review Accommodation Determination

- AC notifies student and appropriate COM-P stakeholders of determination.
