Description

Summer Scrubs is a health career exploration program that helps young people prepare for their future in the health professions by providing the opportunity to participate in professional lectures, health-related fieldtrips, and hands-on lab experiences. The Explore Medical School sessions are for current 11th grade students who are interested in becoming a physician. Participants will explore several physician specialties by learning from various medical doctors.

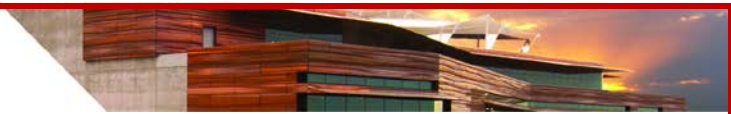
