

## **Explore Medicine Program (Residential)**

#### Description

Summer Scrubs is a health career exploration program that helps young people prepare for their future in the health professions by providing the opportunity to participate in professional lectures, health-related fieldtrips, and hands-on lab experiences. The Explore Medicine Program sessions are for current 11<sup>th</sup> grade students (rising seniors) who are interested in becoming a physician. Participants will explore several physician specialties by learning from various medical doctors.

## **Additional Information**

**Session Dates:** June 1- June 7 All participants are required to attend all days of the session.

**Time:** Check-In will be Sunday, June 1st at 4:00pm and Check-Out will be on Saturday, June 7<sup>th</sup> by 12:00pm.

#### Grade: Current 11<sup>th</sup> grade students (rising seniors)

**Eligibility:** Consideration will be given to students that meet one or more of the following criteria, but all students are welcomed in our program:

- Socioeconomically disadvantaged
- First generation college student
- From rural Arizona
- Member of Federally recognized American Indian Tribe

#### Camp Size: 24 students

**Location:** UA College of Medicine- Phoenix, Downtown Phoenix (435 N. 5<sup>th</sup> ST. Phoenix, AZ 85004) **Lodging:** AC Hotel, Downtown Phoenix

**Cost:** \$500 \*Need-based scholarships are available\*

(costs include room & board, camp activities, meals, scrubs, t-shirt, group transportation during camp, and group evening activities, movies, ice-cream, others TBD)
