

Explore Medicine Program (Residential)

Description

Summer Scrubs is a health career exploration program that helps young people prepare for their future in the health professions by providing the opportunity to participate in professional lectures, health-related fieldtrips, and hands-on lab experiences. The Explore Medicine Program sessions are for current 11th grade students (rising seniors) who are interested in becoming a physician. Participants will explore several physician specialties by learning from various medical doctors.

Additional Information

Session Dates: June 2- June 8

All participants are required to attend all days of the session.

Time: Check-In will be Sunday, June 2nd at 4:00pm and Check-Out will be on Saturday, June 8th at 12:00pm.

Grade: Current 11th grade students (rising seniors)

Eligibility: Consideration will be given to students that meet one or more of the following criteria, but all students are welcomed in our program:

- Socioeconomically disadvantaged
- First generation college student
- From rural Arizona
- Member of Federally recognized American Indian Tribe

Camp Size: 24 students
