



## The Healthcare Team

### Description

Summer Scrubs is a health career exploration program that helps young people prepare for their future in the health professions by providing the opportunity to participate in professional lectures and hands-on lab experiences. The Healthcare Team session is for current 9th and 10th grade students (rising sophomores & juniors) who are interested in a healthcare career, but who are unsure as to which path to take. Participants will explore several healthcare occupations by learning from medical doctors, physician assistants, nurses, pharmacists, dentists and others who make-up the healthcare team.

**Session Dates:** June 15- June 18 (no camp on June 19 in observation of Juneteenth) All participants are required to attend all days of the session.

**Grades:** Current 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students (rising sophomores & juniors)

**Camp Size:** 36 students

**Location:** Phoenix Biomedical Campus, Downtown Phoenix (435 N. 5<sup>th</sup> St. Phoenix, AZ 85004)

**Cost:** \$250 \*Need-based scholarships are available\*

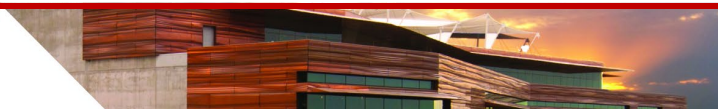

- *How do I apply for a scholarship?* You can complete the optional scholarship application within the program application.
- *May I apply if I am currently in 8<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grade?* The Healthcare Team Summer Scrubs session is for 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students (at the time of submitting application) only. The Explore Medical School sessions are for current students in 11<sup>th</sup> grade.
