



The Health Care Team

Description

Summer Scrubs is a health career exploration program that helps young people prepare for their future in the health professions by providing the opportunity to participate in professional lectures, health-related fieldtrips, and hands-on lab experiences. The Health Care Team sessions are for current 9th and 10th grade students who are interested in a health care career, but who are unsure as to which path to take. Participants will explore several health care occupations by learning from medical doctors, physician assistants, nurses, and others who make-up the health care team.

All participants are required to attend all days of the session. Absences will not be excused and will result in dismissal from the program.

Grades: Current 9th and 10th grade students approaching 10th and 11th grade.

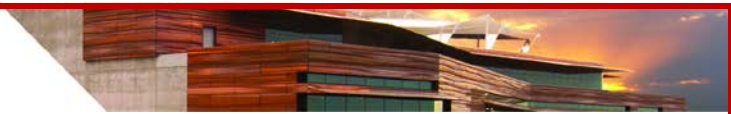
