- ✓ Complete survey
- ✓ Download/screenshot/print your **certificate** that shows your name and that you have completed the self-assessment AND video lessons you will need to show on June 15 upon sign in for your session!
- ✓ Learners will NOT be able to stay for their skills we cannot verify completion of BOTH sections of this module. Please let us know in advance if you are having trouble.
- 2) In-Person skills: June 15 You will be assigned either an AM or PM session to attend.
 - You must bring your certificate of completion this could be a screenshot
 - Complete the review questions for review during class before ACLS stations
 - Location: Banner University Medical Center Phoenix- specific ROOMS will be assigned
