For residents/fellows with an interest in physician leadership development and through formal training, cultivating their leadership potential with a goal of improving their ability to provide excellent patient care, effectively manage healthcare teams and confidently navigate the ever-changing field of healthcare.



Addressing Health Disparities

For residents & fellows interested in gaining the knowledge, skills, and methods necessary to: (a) effectively address health disparities at the patient and healthcare system level and (b) advocate for health policies that further health equity by systemically addressing those disparities.



Resident as Educator

Provides additional training for residents & fellows to gain knowledge, skills, and methods necessary to serve as educators and educational leaders within their clinical roles, and serve as a foundation for those interested in further development as leaders within medical education.



Patient Safety & Analytics Training for Housestaff

Provides additional training for residents and fellows to gain knowledge, skills, and methods necessary to serve as patient safety and quality improvement leaders within their clinical roles. Participants develop and apply patient safety and quality improvement principles while designing and implementing a meaningful project that can continue beyond completion of the certificate program..

Provides additional training for residents & fellows to engage with complex ethical dilemmas that extend beyond introductory principles. It emphasizes high-stakes clinical scenarios, contested values, and the intersection of ethics with law, policy and technology.
