Accomplishments

- Our program has consistently produced high quality, well trained orthopaedic surgeons who continue their education in fellowships and enter very successful practices.
- Since the first graduate of the program in 2011, there have been a total of 41 graduates, and 40 out of 41 (98%) have passed the written exam on the first try, and 28 out of 29 (97%) have passed the oral board exams on the first try, per the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery.
- In 2021, our residents scored, as a group, in the 74th percentile of the 238 North American programs participating in the Orthopaedic In-Training Examination (OITE). The year prior they scored in the 88th percentile. This continues to be a notable achievement, and credit is given to the program as a whole and in particular to the residents and faculty.

Strengths

- 1. Our main goal is to train very knowledgeable and highly skilled orthopaedic surgeons to provide excellent patient care.
- 2. Program focuses strongly on research, requiring yearly projects which are presented at the Annual Resident Research Symposium.
- 3. Our faculty come from diverse backgrounds and have a wide variety of research interests and opportunities for resident involvement.
