College Requirement (department requirements may be higher)

Tenure	Requirement for scholarship (either discovery, clinical or educational).	
Clinical Scholar	Contribute to clinical, educational and research missions of the College, provide significant service and participate in scholarship, predominantly clinical.	
Educator Scholar	Dedicated to College educational mission. Scholarship expected to focus is on curriculum and program development, teaching methods and other educational focus, including such activities as participation in national organizations, educational research and development of educational tools.	
Clinical Series	Physicians and clinical educators who contribute to training of College medical students, residents or fellows. Clinical teaching is a major responsibility, but other activities are credited in the promotion process. Scholarship is required for promotion to clinical professor.	
Research Series	Active contribution to the research mission of the College. This may include independent researchers, members of a collaborative group or someone supporting another's research program. Involved in teaching, service and mentoring.	
Professor of Practice	Active contribution to the training and education of College medical students, residents, fellows or faculty.	
Lecturer	Active in the undergraduate (BS degree) or graduate (MS and PhD) educational mission of the College.	
Specialty Instructor	Membership in good standing as a non-physician health care provider engaged in the education mission. Provides outstanding instruction and has regular and direct contact with the College's medical students, residents or fellows.	
Faculty Physician	Engaged in patient care services through B-UMG. <u>Not engaged</u> in the College's education or research mission. (Examples include locums, telemedicine, physicians only providing clinical services.)
