Urine Drug Screen Requirement

It is the policy of The University of Arizona College of Medicine – Phoenix (COM – P) that students are functioning free from the influence of illicit or illegal substances. Therefore, prior to matriculation and prior to beginning clinical activities at affiliate sites that require drug screening, students must complete a 12-Panel Urine Drug Screening (UDS). This is a specific 12-Panel screening for the following agents:

Amphetamines, Barbiturates, Benzodiazepines, Cannabinoids, Cocaine, Fentanyl, Meperidine, Methadone, Opiates, Oxycodone, Phencyclidine, and Propoxyphene.

Each student will be responsible for the cost of the UDS. Students may select a site of their choice for completion. However, UA COM-Phoenix is contracted with Certiphi to offer a discounted rate of \$40 at locations nationwide. If you would like to use Certiphi for your UDS, please contact Michael Behlke, Credentialing Coordinator at mbehlke@arizona.edu. Once a request has been placed you will be contacted by Certiphi via email to complete the online information, pay the fee and they will give you a list of locations near you to complete the UDS. Please remember to upload your results into your MyRecordTracker account.
