### Hours of Operation:

Students are allowed in the Health Sciences Education Building only when a security guard is present. ## **CatCard**

The CatCard is the official University of Arizona identification card. This information is needed because only students, faculty, staff, and some affiliates of the University of Arizona are eligible to receive a CatCard. This number will not appear on the face of your CatCard, but it will be encoded electronically on your card, to be used for necessary University of Arizona internal purposes only. The number will not be provided to outside entities without your prior consent.
